Pray against injustice, discrimination, violence, and hunger/famine. Pray for health and education, the unemployed, world leaders, spiritual and physical healing. Pray for God to open new doors.

18th - US Military

Pray for the men and women of our Armed Forces who are sacrificing their lives to protect our country.

19th - Nazarene Denomination

Pray for our General Superintendents, General Secretary, and other leaders.

20th - Corporate America

Pray God will provide businesses with leaders who are committed to conducting themselves honorably and with strong ethics. Pray God will raise up His ambassadors in the workplace.

21st - Education

Ask the Lord to raise up a new generation of dedicated educators who will commit themselves not only to an honest, accurate presentation of all subject matter, but who will also serve as positive role models for their students. Uphold our local school boards as they make decisions

about the various curricula that are used across the country. Pray for safety, morally sound instruction and wholesome environments in our local schools including our neighbors at Fremont Elementary.

Kid's Connection provides a safe, fun environment where children learn how to live like Christ. The children learn scripture and spiritual principles through games, music, activities, crafts and playing.

Nursery ages 6 weeks—23 months Sundays, 9:15-11:30 AM. Located upstairs in the Nursery hallway. While parents enjoy adult worship, they can rest assured their little ones are receiving excellent care.

Preschool—Kindergarten Sundays, 9:15-11:30 AM. This isn't just babysitting! Your child will meet new friends and participate in various age-appropriate activities that reinforce the lesson. They will join the other children for a special worship time in The Connection room (the children's worship area downstairs) and then go back upstairs to the last room on the right in the Nursery hallway for their lesson, craft and activities.

GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

The ministries at Trinity are entirely supported by our attenders. Without the participation of everyone through giving, attendance, serving and prayer, we would not be able to offer ministries that love people to Christ and help them journey with God.

The Bible teaches us a baseline standard for giving: the tithe. When we give the first 10% of our income to the church, we put God first in our lives. Tithing is an act of worship that expresses our gratitude, faith and love for God and others. Your tithes and offerings support the work of the Lord by caring for our pastors and staff and by meeting operational and general ministry expenses. Other offerings at Trinity include Mission Partners and Above and Beyond Projects.

Trinity Church of the Nazarene reserves the right to refuse any donation for any reason. To ensure all gifts are effectively used, no gift will be accepted that is unduly restrictive, likely to result in a net loss for the church, or may be designated for a purpose outside the mission of the church.

Ways to Give:

Automated Bill pay is an easy and effective way to automate your giving. Once it is set up, your gift will be sent directly to Trinity as a one-time gift or can be set up as a monthly payment. You can update or change your giving at any time and 100% of your gift goes to the ministries of Trinity because there are no processing fees. To sign-up, contact your local bank or sign-up on their website.

Mail Checks can be mailed to the church office or dropped in the mail slot just outside our church office.

Onsite While attending our weekly worship service, you can use a tithe envelope or simply drop a check in the offering plate.

Text Giving Text donations can be made safely and securely by texting any dollar amount to [\(719\) 285-4665](tel:7192854665) (Ex. \$100). To give to Mission Partners, text a dollar amount and Missions to the same number (Ex. \$100 Missions). The first time you give through text, you will need to enter your credit card information.

Planned and Legacy Giving

Leave a legacy of faith, now or beyond your lifetime, while reflecting your values and priorities. As a part of your planned giving, (inheritance, estate, wills, etc.), gifts can be designated to the following funds:

Church Ministries Fund Used to launch new ministries or expand and enhance existing ministries. This fund will provide initial funding for ministry expansion while long-term funding will be supported with general funds of the church. This fund is not intended to replace ministry funding through regular tithes and offerings.

Missions Fund Intended to supplement regular missions giving and can be used for Work and Witness, direct missionary gifts, or other mission oriented projects designed to take the Gospel throughout the world.

Church Property Fund Used for capital expenditures such as building, land or equipment with an expected life of ten years or more. This could include new acquisitions, facility additions or major repairs such as roof or HVAC replacement.

Benevolent/Compassionate Needs Donations will be used to supply needs for those in our congregation and in our community.

Unrestricted Fund Gifts will be used as determined by the Church Board for future ministry needs.
